FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

1. What is The Alfred Nobel Academic Grants (ANAG)?

The ANAG is a 2-year academic grant for Senior High School students of Westfield Science Oriented School. It is open to all completing Junior High School students of PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS with exceptional abilities in verbal/non-verbal, science and math subjects. **The selection process is centered on the academic records and results of the personal (online) interview with the applicant.** Once a selected applicant accepts the academic grant, the student shall be required to finish his/her **Senior High School** course under the WSOS' educational program. The scholarship will be granted in the form of a Tuition and Miscellaneous Fees Waiver of the remaining amount of the total yearly matriculation fees less the amount covered by the Deped Voucher of the student. **The recipient of the grant is also assured that there will be NO TOP-UP or additional matriculation fees during his/her tenure in school.**

2. What are the eligibilities to qualify and where can a student get a copy of ANAG Application Form?

The applicant i.) must be a completing Junior High School student or a G10 level of current academic year, ii.) must not have grades lower than 80% in any subject during the THIRD QUARTER or equivalent period and, iii.) must have good deportment grades. The application form is FREE OF CHARGE and can be accessed through wsosonline.net.

3. How can a qualified applicant avail of the scholarship grant?

A qualified applicant is required to accomplish the Scholarship Application Form ONLINE at www.wsosonline.net. The Admissions Office will conduct a thorough interview of the applicant with the parent or guardian present. All decisions of the School Board in the selection and screening of scholars are final. Only those selected after the final screening will be chosen as beneficiaries of the academic grants.

4. Is there a qualifying examination for the academic grant?

The qualifying examinations is **COMPLETELY WAIVED** for SY2021-2022. Similarly, **NO Entrance Test** shall be administered to Incoming Grade 11 students.

5. When is the deadline for submission of application?

The Admissions Office will continue to accept applications until the slots are filled-up.
